037/15 KCVC Minutes 2014-06-19 were accepted subject to the following **amendments**

038/15 Members of the public Questions/statements

- PaT Berry asked about rules for certificated caravan sites. Brief explanation given briefly.
- Ivy Redfern said the Consultation display was very interesting.
- Keith Laver praised presentation of consultation and asked for the details of the Council's solicitor and insurers re a statement in the display.

039/15 County Councillors report - (Cllr Peck) Squires Lane being repaired (patched). Thoresby Pit Closure will have impact on local economy. Pressing for passenger rail service to Ollerton. Joint funding for new Visitor Centre has fallen through and NCC will be looking for new funding partner later this year.

040/15 District Councillors report - Apologies from Cllr Soar – report mentioned Kelham Hall sold –NSDC moving to a new build near Newark Castle Gate Station. Rumbles has been funded for next 10 years. Possibility of rail passenger service to Ollerton, No future funding for Vicar Water fun days. Update on Headstocks.

043/15 Neighbourhood Plan

- (a) Report – Cllr Parkhouse reported success of consultation so far - 70 forms in (+three visitors) Overwhelmingly positive. Keith Laver has been sent a blank village map to submit his preferred village envelope (handed in during the meeting). Mr Laver also had emailed the Acting Clerk to ask for the evidence to substantiate the Village Council's comment re-N.C.C.Highways. Cllr Parkhouse read out Highways planning comments re caravans turning in- that it was '*to the detriment of highway safety.*'
- (b) Village consultation venue payment – payment approved 2 weeks rental of £40 for the Iron Chapel

044/15 Recruitment of new Clerk to the Council – Five applicants - Cllrs Govan, Bradley & Parkhouse to shortlist this week, Cllr Rowe to replace Cllr Parkhouse (away) for interviews in August (evening interviews)

045/15 Request for use of the Notice Boards – David Collinson asked Cllr Parkhouse for access to the locked notice boards so that a shadow parish council group, intending to contest next year's election, could put notices up. The meeting resolved that the open notice board on Squires Lane was available for any community use, but the official boards could not legally be used for such political purposes.

046/15 Dog Bin Keith Laver has requested a Dog Bin on the Dog & Duck bridleway to help deal with the dog fouling. The Acting Clerk is to cost bins and posts and identify sites (plus include one for Archway Rd)

047/15 Sherwood Pines concert event – Dangerous parking on the verge – Acting Clerk to contact NCC Highways re parking restrictions next year on B6030, Mill Lane & Archway Rd.
Cllr Macguire to contact Sherwood Pines to find out who deals with the concert organisation.
