Minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting held on 15 April 2019 at 7.00 pm in Council Chambers, Edwinstowe Village Hall, Mansfield Road, Edwinstowe

1. Apologies

2. Minutes of the 2018 Annual Parish Meeting

These were approved and signed as a correct record.

3. Chair's Report

Cllr Bromley referred to the Neighbourhood Plan, which has now been adopted by Newark and Sherwood District Council, and thanked Cllr Stanley in particular for all the work he had taken on to get the plan completed. It will be subject to a five year review.

A 50 mph restriction in Gorsethorpe Lane has now been implemented, and attempts are being made to get a reduction to 30 mph along Cavendish Road.

The village now has two Christmas trees, and there are numerous spring bulbs on display. Chair thanked those responsible for planting.

Sherwood Pines has now agreed to consult with the Parish Council on matters concerning concerts taking place on this site, especially in regard to traffic issues.

Cllr Bromley thanked fellow councillors, and in particular Cllr Alice Dunn, who was not seeking re-election.

4. Parish Council Accounts

Cllr Bromley went through the accounts, and explained some extra payments which were made during the financial year. The Parish Council ended the year with £24,676.25, which was slightly down on the previous year. There were no questions on the accounts,

There being no further business, Cllr Bromley thanked those present for their attendance, and closed the meeting at 7.09 pm
