## Minutes of the Meeting of Kings Clipstone Parish Council on 19<sup>th</sup> October 2020 at 7.00pm online via Zoom.

### 1. Welcome

The Chairman opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.

### 2. Apologies for absence

Unanimously approved.

### 3. Declarations of Interest in Items on the Agenda

There were none.

### 4. Approval of the minutes of the meeting held on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> September 2020.

The minutes were unanimously approved by all present at the meeting and signed by the Chair.

### 5. County Councillor's Report

No C/Cllr present.

### 6. District Councillors' Report

D/Cllr Carlton had written to the John Eastwood Foundation in support of an application that KCPC have submitted to them. D/Cllr Carlton explained that their meetings were infrequent, however there is usually an October meeting.

D/Cllr Carlton reported that all committees are now meeting virtually, however much time is being given to localised outbreaks including secondment of officers.

D/Cllr Carlton reported that there had been two more fires at Birklands, and a home visit to the resident has been requested from Environmental Health.

D/Cllr Brown reported putting speeding signs up with Cllr Stanley. Operation Reacher has been in the area regarding speeding and anti-social behaviour, including unmarked police cars being out to manage traffic.

D/Cllr Brown discussed possible funding for the new toilets on the playing field which is still in progress. He has asked NSDC to review the reasoning that the grant was unsuccessful from the town initiative fund applied for previously, as the application scored 97/100.

D/Cllr Brown reported problems with the Crown Surgery and difficulty getting appointments. The senior leadership of the practice are to take the concerns to the CCG.

D/Cllr Brown encouraged the councillors to report any anti social behaviour.

## **7. Planning Matters**

### **a. Applications received:**

20/01793/FUL / Barnsdale, 5 Old Barn Court, Kings Clipstone

Proposed single storey wrap around extension with loft conversion to existing garage to form new granny annexe.

A discussion took place and it was unanimously approved to make no comment on the proposal.

### **b. Decision notices:**

20/01084/FUL / Eastfield Cottage Farm, Clipstone Road, Kings Clipstone, NG21 9JN

Full permission was granted.

## **8. To receive an update on Covid-19 cases in the village**

In the week up to the 14<sup>th</sup> October there were 32 cases in Edwinstowe, Clipstone and Kings Clipstone. There is only one case currently known to councillors in the village.

## **9. To receive an update on groundworks for the field**

Cllr Stanley reported that work has started to the playing field surface, in particular aeration. Top soil is on order and it will be continued in a few weeks time.

## **10. To receive an update on electricity supply renewal**

The council supply has been renewed and is 100% renewable energy to be as green as possible.

## **11. To receive an update on whether planning permission is required for the proposed toilets**

Cllr Stanley reported checking with Lisa Hughes from planning. It has been suggested that KCPC apply for and get established building certificates to prevent future issues with the structures on the playing field.

## **12. To receive an update on grant applications**

Cllr Hunt not present, deferred until next meeting.

## **13. To discuss plans for Remembrance Day**

A silent soldier now stands on the banking opposite the King John's Palace. A plaque is to be put next to the soldier along with a cargo net covered with handmade poppies by residents of Kings Clipstone. Poppies are to be displayed on lamp posts as normal.

## **14. To receive an update on the traffic survey for Gorsethorpe Lane**

Cllr Stanley shared an update received from VIA, and results of the traffic survey should be available within 4 weeks after the 21st October. Results are to be made available to C/Cllr John Peck however Cllr Stanley will request that the council receive a copy.
